




## In the Old Sun

The poorhouse derelicts of Gerbersau (Hesses boyhood town of Cawl) appear to have walked out of the fictional world of Gottfried Keller, whose collection of short stories, The People of Seldwyla, was a favorite of Hesses. The antics of Hrlin, the bankrupt manufacturer, and of Heller, a malicious and lazy former rope maker, are both humorous and poignant.
