PCBs in levels above those permitted by Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) in surface water were detected. PCBs have been classified as probable carcinogens by the International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC) and through research; they have also been classified as endocrine disrupting compounds (EDCs).
