Also of especial importance here is the correction which the author was at last able to make concerning an old phrase (salvation from sins and/or punishments of the world) that had been taken for granted in certain previous books, but was dealt its final death-blow here in what, with its philosophical consistency and greater profundity, he likes to think of as his ultimate cyclical work.
